














Merida, the capital city of Yucatan is the best place to start your tour and explore the state. Founded in 1542 and built on the site of the ancient Mayan city of T'ho, it is unique thanks to its colonial historic downtown full of European architectural influence and a notable French style that can be seen in the large mansions located along its main avenue, the historic Paseo de Montejo.

The Merida city route offers many cultural, historical, entertainment, and gastronomical options. We suggest you start your visit in the historic downtown area, where you can stroll through the half dozen old Barrios (neighborhoods) that date back to the founding of the city and remain. Admire the great variety of colonial buildings and theaters that coexist with modern museums and galleries. Enjoy the atmosphere of outdoor cafés, bars, and restaurants featuring regional, national, and international cuisines. Do not forget to stop by our typical clothes and craft stores.

New Jurassic trail in Progreso

66 million years ago, a massive meteor crashed into and changed the face of our planet and gave the Yucatan peninsula an unalterable place in history. While the impact's epicenter itself cannot be observed from the ground, Port of Progreso has taken upon itself the task of showcasing its historical value with a new attraction that aims to educate and entertain visitors with representations of animated and non-animated dinosaurs.

The brand-new and recently inaugurated Sendero Jurasico (Jurassic trail) consists of a walking path that visitors can stroll through by themselves and see different



dinosaurs along with markers that provide information on each of the creatures represented in the area. Also available are local bilingual guides that can take guests along the trail and accompany them, providing a more indepth educational experience.

At the midpoint of the trail, visitors can enjoy refreshments in the cafeteria where there are signature snacks and local traditional street foods on offer. Guests can also feed different species of turtles in a special nursery.

Easy to find, the Sendero Jurasico is a short 20-minute drive from the Progreso Cruise Ship Terminal and any of the local taxi drivers will be happy to take you there.

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Located just 2 miles from the archeological site of Chichen Itza, this wonderful park is surrounded by exotic plants and trees, which makes it

the perfect habitat for a wide range of wild bird species. Here a restaurant and a hotel, share a majestic cenote framed with hanging vegetation. The entrance, down a stone stairway, leads to small stone terraces that allow you to admire the beauty surrounding you. Once on the main platform, you will have access to the cenote's fresh water, clear and refreshing and at the same time very deep and mysterious.



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A day at the Sotuta de Peon sisal plantation is like traveling back in time when these properties, called haciendas, were an everyday reality in Yucatan.

Located 1 hour from the Port of Progreso, touring the property and its henequen (sisal) fields, along with its outbuildings will allow you to learn about this industry, which was the basis for the local economy for a long time. Immerse yourself in the experience with the help of all the stories narrated in a captivating way by the guides of the hacienda.

The site also features its own beautiful cenote, a restaurant with excellent regional food, and a spa.



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The Grand Mayan World Museum is a modern and avant-garde cultural space. The architectural design of the museum was inspired by the ceiba tree, which is considered one of the pillars of Mayan culture.

The museum showcases a magnificent collection of more than 1,160 pieces, from different eras in local history, such as textiles, religious objects, engravings, artistic and religious works from colonial times; along with stelae, bas-reliefs, and stone sculptures from pre-hispanic times. It has four permanent exhibition halls, each dedicated to a specific theme.
