
Friends of Health **Compliance**

The pandemic is ongoing, as are the efforts to control its effects. To contain the effects on tourism and the general population, the state of Yucatan still has in place mandatory health measures and protocols such as the use of face masks, social distancing, hand washing and sanitization.

As an important part of maintaining the health of cruise ship passengers arriving in Progreso, as well as ensuring
