The port of Progreso has great maritime accessibility, as part of the Western Caribbean routes for cruise ships and enjoys a strategic location that makes it very important in terms of connectivity.




With the goal to have a system of good sanitary practices based on models that will aid in preventing the spread of infections in the tourist industry, we develop the Biosecurity Risk Prevention Certification of Yucatán (BUPSY).



As of February 15th, 2021, considering various factors including hospital occupancy, contagion rates, new cases, among others, the statewide alert level went to orange on the Yucatan economic recovery traffic light system.

656,044 Pfizer-BioNTech
vaccines have been applied
from December 24th to January
27th in México. At this day, the
contracts for vaccines in México
are with Pfizer-BioNTech,
AstraZeneca, Sputnik V and
Cansino-Bio. As far as the
results of phase III vaccines of
Novavax (USA), and CureVac
(Germany) are ready.

In Yucatan, a total of 27,300 vaccines will have been received between January 12th and February of 2021, with which health personnel has been inoculated.



SITUATION IN CONTEXT OF COVID-19

The COVID-19 pandemic has presented the global community and the tourism sector, with important and constantly evolving challenges.

The port of Progreso has continued to operate and remains open for cargo, oil and trade. However, cruise ship activity was halted as a preventative measure in agreement with the cruise lines and the U.S. government to curtail the spread of COVID-19.

Explore Kabah's Mayan Ruins by 4x4 Land Rover

Explore the wonders of the Kabah Mayan Ruins on this exciting expedition. Then drive a vintage Land Rover through the jungle and learn about Yucatan history. Explore the most famous structure at Kabah known as the "Palace of the Masks", featuring a faced adorned with hundreds of stone carvings of the rain God Chaac. See the two impressive sculptures that grace the opening of one of the temples - amazingly wellpreserved, considering their age and exposure to the elements.







Afterwards, hop into your vintage Land Rovers, just like what the British archaeologists used at the beginning of the excavation and restoration of Kabah and Chichén Itza. You will drive these classic, rugged vehicles through the jungle, past local fruit plantations and onto an old hacienda, where you will learn information about this important period in





