Yucatan Tourism Board and local authorities welcomed her and the cruise ships' captain and officers with ceremony where gifts and commemorative plaques were exchanged.



## Highlights

Everyone knows that Seatrade Cruise Global is the largest showcase for everyone involved in the cruise industry. The 2023 edition took place at Broward County Convention Center in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

On this occasion we joined 4 destinations to be part of the Ports of Mexico stand, featuring the Port of Chiapas, Port of Ensenada, Puerto Mágico (Puerto Vallarta) and of course, Port of Progreso, Yucatan. After the inaugural ribbon cutting, with the participation of special guests like Mexico's ambassador and the CEO of FCCA, Michele Paige as well as other dignitaries, all the ports participated enthusiastically in the promotion of each destination.





There are increasing challenges for all ports that receive cruise ships, especially when it comes to ship's sizes and capacities, which are becoming greater each year. For this reason we consider it important to update the work that is carried out in Progreso.

On this occasion we had the support of the General Director of ASIPONA Progreso, Admiral Jorge Carlos Tobilla Rodriguez, as well as the mayor of Progreso, Julián Zacarías, both of whom attended some of the meetings with cruise industry executives that took place during the 3 days of exhibition.



Representatives of all the participating ports were able to hold meetings with executives, establish relationships with new contacts from other countries and share experiences and business models with one another.

After being absent for many years, Mexico successfully reappeared on the show floor. With our participation we want to set a precedent for future editions of Seatrade with a united front as a country destination.

#### Carnaval in Yucatan

Progreso celebrated Carnaval for the first time since shutting down for COVID. The festivities stretched out over two weeks with ceremonies, concerts, and parades that saw Progreso receive around 800 thousand people. Most events and parades were nighttime events, except for the traditional "Batalla de las Flores" (Battle of the Flowers) that invaded the boardwalk on the last day of Carnaval parades.



This year, this last daytime parade coincided with the arrival of the Carnival Breeze, which required special operations that needed to be coordinated between local authorities and Carnival to facilitate transit of cruise passengers from the cruise terminal and avoid delays.






#### THE PORT IN NUMBERS
